CONFIRMATION certificate. If it was held back home, they must contact the church In



that country and request a copy

\$60 registration fee

Certificate of Marriage IF GODPARENTS ARE MARRIED TO EACHOTHER.

Once all documents are collected, please contact the office to have an appointment set up
