ALL ABOUT FAITH

Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

The first form of communion between persons is that born of the love of a man and a woman who decide to enter a stable union in order to build together a new family... The natural family, as an intimate communion of life and love, based on marriage between a man and a woman, constitutes "the primary

place of 'humanization' for the person and society," and a "cradle of life and love"...Indeed, in a healthy family life we experience some of the fundamental elements of peace: justice and love between brothers and sisters, the role of authority expressed by parents, loving concern for the members who are weaker because of youth, sickness or old age, mutual help in the necessities of life, readiness to accept others and, if necessary, to forgive them. For this reason, the family is the first and indispensable teacher of peace...Where can young people gradually learn to savor the genuine "taste" of peace better than in the original "nest" which nature prepares for them?...This point merits special reflection: everything that serves to weaken the family based on the marriage of a man and a woman, everything that directly or indirectly stands in the way of its openness to the responsible acceptance of a new life, everything that obstructs its right to be primarily responsible for the education of its children, constitutes an objective obstacle on the road to peace.

Holy Family of Nazareth, be a model of tranquility and harmony for all families. Give powerful graces to husbands and wives, children and siblings, to overcome differences so they can build a common life with your own as a model.


