

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Just recently, I dusted a small book which I received as gift some five years ago. Despite the catchy title, Unleash the Magnet in You. The Ultimate Challenge, I never really gave it any chance. But now that I have, I am beginning to realize what I have been missing. The Gospel reading of today (Matthew 5.1-12) presents what could be considered the ultimate challenge for Christians today: Blessedness or, better, Happiness. What makes happy? Webinar by ICCJ: From Antijudaism to Contemporary Antisemitism: Continuities and Discontinuities Sunday, Feb 05, 2023 at 07:00 PM - Virtual

Hostility toward Jews is a phenomenon notable for its longevity and durability. While the term "antisemitism" was only coined in the late 19th century, Jews were hated, persecuted, and discriminated against for many centuries before. A wide variety of reasons were given to justify this animus (e.g., theological, political, racial), often reflecting dramatically different contexts and worldviews. This indicates some of the discontinuities between expressions of hostility toward Jews in diverse settings. However, there are stunning continuities as well, even in these very different settings. This reveals some of the common features of antisemitism and the surprisingly persistent influence of certain ideas. Join us for a discussion of the complexity of claims of both continuity and discontinuity in hostility toward Jews and how this is relevant in the present, a time when such hostility is increasing.

The Presentation of the Lord (Feb 02)

At the heart of this celebration is the encounter of Simeon and Anna with the Christ Child in the Temple. It is in that holv encounter that Jesus' divinity is manifested by a human prophet for the first time. At His birth, the angels proclaimed His divinity to the shepherds, but in the Temple, Simeon

was the first to understand and proclaim Jesus as the Savior of the World. He also prophesied that this salvation would be accomplished by a sword of sorrow that would pierce the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Anna, a prophetess, also came forward and "gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem" (Luke 2:38). Thus, these ritual acts were also a moment in which Jesus' divine mission was made manifest to the world.

Ponder, today, your soul being the new temple of the Lord, and acknowledge your need to be purified and offered to the Father in Heaven. As Christ continues to enter into the temple of your soul, pray that He will shine forth for others to see so that, like Simeon and Anna, they will encounter our Lord within you.
