# THIS WEEK AT ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

#### From the Associate Pastor's Desk "Sir, we wish to see Jesus"

The first reading from Prophet Jeremiah 31:31-34 envisions the conclusion of the new covenant of God with His people. This covenant will not be etched in stone. Rather it would be written or inscribed in the human heart. The second reading from the letter to the Hebrews 5:7-9 and the Gospel John 12:20-33 highlight the person and the means of ratifying the new covenant. He, Who the focus of the verses is no other than God Himself in the second Person of the Blessed Trinity, Jesus Christ. The means with which Jesus Christ would put into effect this new covenant would be through taking up His Cross in obedience, suffering and death. Thus, "Very truly, I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain; but if t dies, it bears much fruit". The Gospel insists and invites us to desire with all our heart and with all our soul to see Jesus. The important question comes to fore. Where can we find Him? Where can we see Him? Apart from finding and seeing Him in His Words and Sacraments, we can truly find Him among the poor, the homeless, among the margins of society and among our neighbours. To find Him, we must see with the lenses of our hearts and not with the lenses of our eves. Have a blessed Sunday!!!

Fifth Sunday of Lent: Suffering Transformed by Glory



"I am troubled now. Yet what should I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name." Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again." John 12:27–28. Our Lord's human soul was "troubled." Other translations state that His soul was in agony. After expressing His interior suffering, Jesus identified the human temptation caused by this suffering: to flee from His "hour." Of course Jesus dismisses this temptation as a way of teaching us a lesson from His human experience. As God, Jesus had perfect strength and always remained faithful to the mission He received from the Father. But as a human, Jesus permitted Himself to experience temptation and human suffering for many reasons. One reason was so that He could relate to us in every way. That includes being able to relate to interior human suffering. In doing so, Jesus also made it possible for us to imitate Him and to share in the strength and determination He had as He perfectly fulfilled the will of the Father. Jesus allowed Himself to endure the agony caused by foreseen suffering because we will endure similar temptations through life.
