### September 23: St. Padre Pio



Reflection: Saint Padre Pio was born Francesco Forgione in Pietrelcina, Italy, a rural town of about 4,000 people. As a child, he was called Franci (Frankie). His parents were peasant farm laborers, and the children assisted with the work. Franci was the third of seven (or eight) children, two (or three) of whom died in

infancy, which was quite common at that time. The town centered around the local church of Saint Anna with continuous feasts, Masses, processions, novenas, and parish festivals. The main festival each year was in honor of their patroness, Our Lady of Deliverance, which lasted three days every August. After the day's work was completed, most evenings were spent with neighbors, eating macaroni, singing, telling stories, and playing in the fields.

Prayer: Saint Padre Pio, you loved God with all your heart and bore the wounds of Christ on your body. Through you, many lives were converted, hearts healed, and sins forgiven. Please pray for me, that I will receive the healing I need so that I will more fully devote myself to the will of God and serve Him with all my might. Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.

# What Are Some Psalms Worth Memorizing For Different Occasions?

For this reason, we do well not only to pray them regularly, but also to commit to memorizing them by heart so that "His praise will always be on my lips" (Ps 34:1). What follows is a small sampling of psalms worth learning for different occasions, following the numbering system employed by the NAB and RSV translations.

**For staying close to Christ:** Psalms 1 and 19 speak movingly of devotion to God's law and the precious fruits that this brings.

**For loving God in times of grief:** Psalm 34 is a gritty, heartfelt prayer of one who has suffered much, yet continues to praise the Lord and find peace in Him

### Eucharist is way to "rebel" against evil: Pope to International Eucharistic Congress



"The lessons we can take in from the Holy Eucharist always surprise us," Pope Francis said in a video message to the participants of the International Eucharistic Congress in Quito, Ecuador, which got underway on September 8 and will run through next Sunday. In his speech, he explained how the Eucharist can teach us to come together as brothers and sisters and allow us to grow united as one body in the Church. "Already the early Church Fathers told us that the sign of bread kindles in the People of God the desire for brotherhood, for just as bread cannot be kneaded from a single grain, so too must we walk together, for 'though we are many, we are one body, one bread," the Pope said.


