ALL ABOUT FAITH

November 11: St. Martin of Tours - Memorial



Reflection: Saint Martin of Tours has been one of the most revered and loved saints in European history for two primary reasons: he lived a life of heroic sanctity, and someone wrote it all down. Sulpicius Severus is believed to have been a wealthy man who

converted to Christianity through the ministry of Bishop Martin. He then became a priest, interviewed Bishop Martin before he died, and wrote a book about Martin's incredible life. The book was copied over and over again and became one of the standard texts for religious and laity alike for many centuries. Numerous churches and monasteries bear Martin's name as a result of his popularity. Though Saint Martin of Tours lived a life of heroic virtue and deep prayer, his life and veneration reveal the importance of sharing the stories of the saints with others. After his death, his life has continued to inspire many. As we honor Saint Martin, ponder any ways that God might want to use you as He used Sulpicius Severus, Saint Martin's biographer. Though you might not be called to write a book about a saint you know, consider ways in which you can share the Gospel by learning more about the saints and sharing their stories with others.

Prayer: Saint Martin of Tours, though you were born into a pagan family, God spoke to your heart from an early age, and you listened and responded. Your kindness, deep prayer, and generosity led to your ongoing conversion, making you an inspiration to all. Please pray for me, that I will always listen to God's voice and respond with all my heart. Saint Martin of Tours, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.— My Catholic Life

Does the Bible Say Whether There are People in Hell?



Today many believers and even many theologians and bishops struggle with the idea of an eternal hell. Sometimes those same people will try to reinterpret Scripture according to their own preconceived notions of what it should or shouldn't say. That is a dangerous path to take. While the doctrine of a populated hell may not be one which we would come up with on our own, it is nevertheless a doctrine which we must accept on the authority of Divine Revelation, and it is one repeatedly corroborated by history's greatest saints, scholars, mystics, and apparitions. If we are to remain faithful to Christ, then our theology must be a theology not of Babel, where we work from the ground up according to our own designs, but rather of Pentecost, where we work on the basis of what has been given to us from Our theology above. must always a received theology, one which builds on the primacy of Sacred Scripture as interpreted through the living Tradition of Holy Mother Church.
